

Maureen will talk to us about *Major General Sir Fabian Ware – "A truly great Gloucestershire man".*

Fabian Ware began his career as a teacher and a journalist. As well as founding the Imperial War Graves Commission, he served the County of Gloucestershire as Chairman of many committees including the Gloucestershire branch of the Council for the Preservation of Rural England. His own grave is in Amberley Churchyard and he is commemorated in Gloucester Cathedral and Westminster Abbey.
