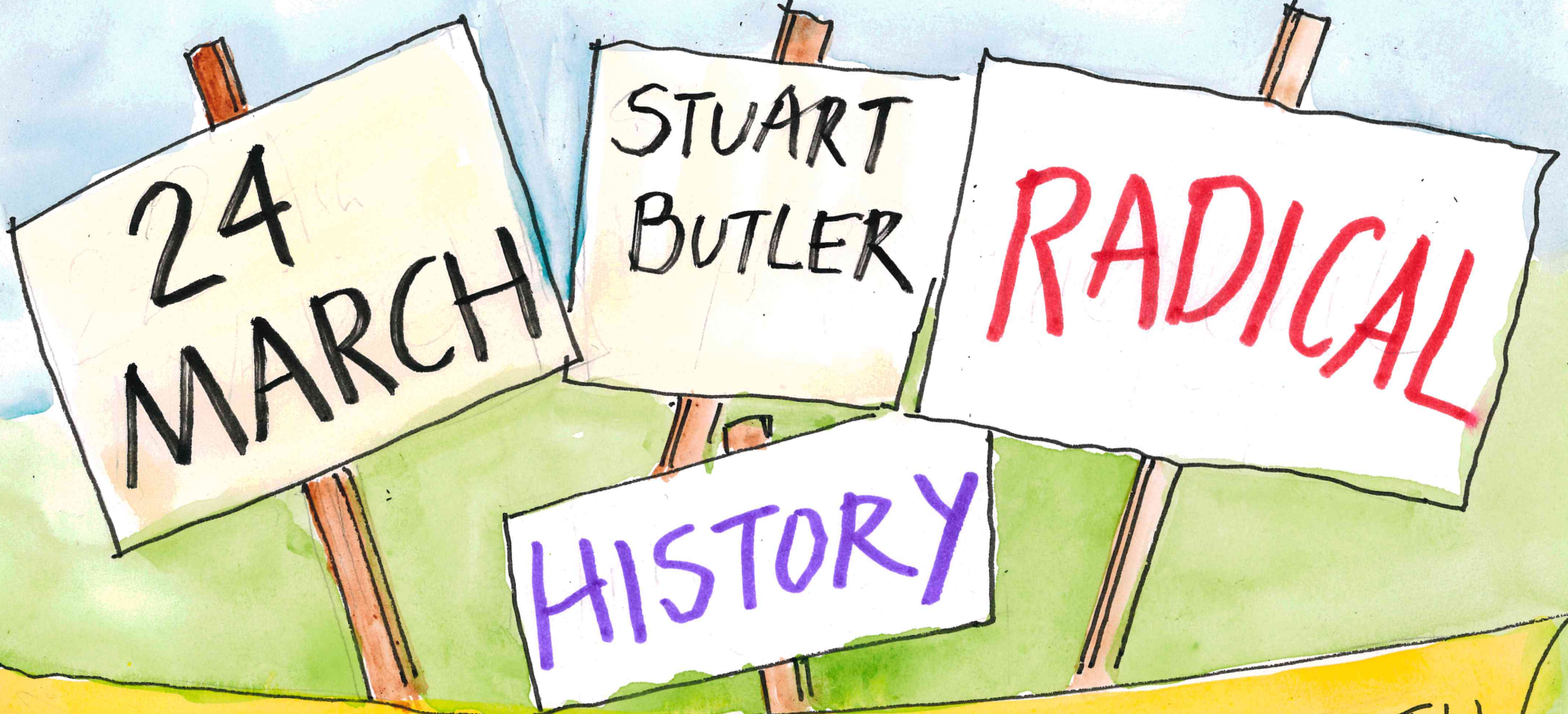


The Nailsworth Society Local Studies
